Yes! Capabilities provides services to individuals from various county Boards of Developmental Disabilities.

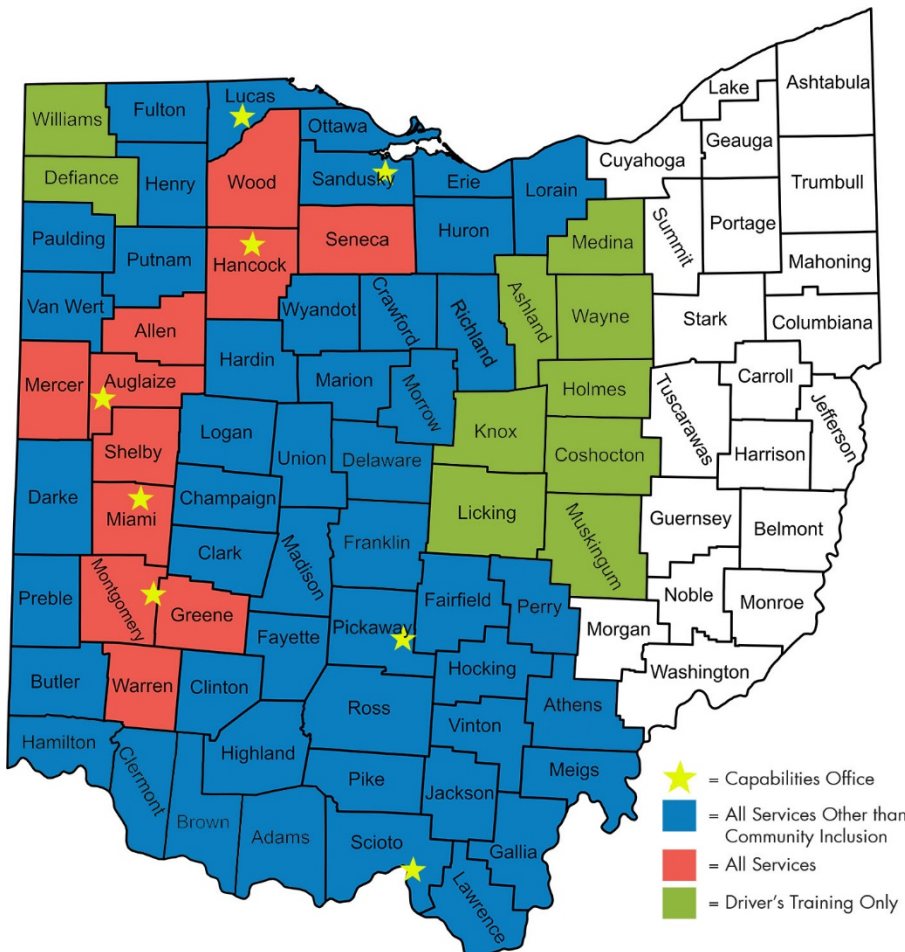

2018 Programs / Services and their Objectives

Capabilities provides the services in these categories: Community Employment, Community Inclusion Services, Driving Services, Transition Services, Professional Training, Technology Services.

Human Resource/ Workforce Development and Management Activities

Total number of personnel increased from 139 to 159 in 2018, for an increase of 14.39%. Average seniority is 3.68 years. Capabilities added 30 new positions in 2018.

- 34% of services provided where Transition Services
- 16% of services provided where Driving Services
- 3% of services provided where Community Inclusion Services
